

## RESOLUTION OF THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN

### ON MEASURES FOR DEVELOPMENT OF PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP IN THE REPUBLIC OF UZBEKISTAN FOR 2024-2030

In pursuance of the strategy "Uzbekistan — 2030", and in order to achieve the target of attracting the private investment in the amount of at least 30 billion US dollars into public-private partnership projects until 2030, to develop of the required social and economic infrastructure in the regions to enhance the high economic growth, disseminate the successful experience in implementation of public-private partnership projects in generation of electric power for other industries:

1. It is hereby approved:

The measures for implementation of prioritized public-private partnership projects in 2024-2026 as listed in the Appendix No. 1\*;

The program of the projects to be implemented based on the public-private partnership in 2024-2030 (further – the Program) in accordance with the Appendix No. 2\*.

\*The appendices are provided in Uzbek.

With this, to consider the necessity in as follows:

construction and modernization of at least 1,000 km of modern toll road, including the beginning of the construction of Tashkent – Samarkand motor way in 2024 and the Tashkent – Andijan motor way in 2026, with an aim of creating additional conditions for convenient and high-speed automobile communication between the major cities;

signing the agreements specifying the transfer of electric power distribution grids to the private operators by July 1, 2027 and natural gas distribution networks by the end of 2027 with a reduction in annual energy losses by two times at least;

execution of agreement on modernization of all obsolete irrigation pumping stations by 2028 to save up to 30 percent of electricity annually;

attracting the private companies into the modernization and management of water supply and sewerage networks in each region by the end of 2028, with provision of clean and uninterrupted potable water supply up to 87 percent, centralized sewerage supply – up to 30 percent;

starting from 2026, organization of annual construction and management of at least 100 schools and 100 pre-school educational institutions based on the principles of public-private partnership (further – PPP) with an aim of establishing modern educational institutions with a capacity of more than 400 thousand students and pre-school educational institutions with a capacity of more than 300 thousand students;

construction of multidisciplinary hospitals to serve more than 100,000 patients and their transfer to private operators to expand the availability of medical services based on advanced technologies.

2. To establish that the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, the khokims of the regions and the city of Tashkent shall bear personal responsibility for allocating the land lots for projects of the Program as per the requests from the Ministry of Pre-school and School Education, with due account of the requirements of international financial institutions.

3. Ministry of Investment, Industry and Trade (L. Kudratov) shall ensure that potential foreign investors will study the promising PPP projects under the organized international and bilateral business forums, and presentations of the investment potential of Uzbekistan (roadshows).

With this, the Ministry of Economy and Finance shall present the work performed in Uzbekistan in terms of PPP, including legislation and promising projects.

4. The heads of ministries and departments, the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, the khokims of the regions and the city of Tashkent shall ensure the high-quality implementation and implementation of the PPP projects under the Program, and their compliance with the standards of environmental protection and social security based on the best international practices.

With this, the Ministry of Economy and Finance (I. Norkulov) shall coordinate the efforts on eliminating the gaps between domestic and international standards and submit regular proposals to the Cabinet of Ministers on eliminating the gap.

5. Ministry of Ecology, Environmental Protection and Climate Change (A. Abdukhakimov) shall submit proposals to the Administration of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan within a week in order to start a project on modernization of the sewerage system in Namangan region and its transfer to a private operator, with eliminating the gaps between European and national standards established for wastewater treatment facilities.

6. The Ministry of Economy and Finance, together with the Ministry of Investment, Industry and Trade and the Ministry of Energy, within a three-month period, shall submit to the Cabinet of Ministers a draft law on amendments and additions to the [Law](#) of the Republic of Uzbekistan "On Public Debt", with specifying the upper cap for obligations to be assumed by the government (take or pay) and issued confirmation letters (Comfort letter) on PPP projects.

7. In pursuance of timely and high-quality implementation of the projects included into the Program, efficient management of funds received by the Public-Private Partnership Fund, including the involvement of consultants into the projects, to incorporate a project office "Center for Public-Private Partnership Projects" (further – the Project Office) with a prescribed staff size and in the form of a government agency within the structure of the Ministry of Economy and Finance.

To establish that:

The Project Office shall organize regular roadshows, round tables and other events, use the international platforms extensively, organize the training workshops on retraining and capacity building of PPP specialists, organize their practice abroad, and receipt of international certificates;

The Project Office shall develop the training programs aimed at increasing the local content in the projects of the Program and expand the project financing in national currency.

The Ministry of Economy and Finance (D. Kuchkarov) within two weeks shall approve the regulations on the Project Office, and its structure, terms of remuneration and financial incentives.

8. The Ministry of Economy and Finance (I. Norkulov) shall:

a) within one month to make proposals on a new mechanism providing for:  
organization of the direct investment funds with participation of the international financial organizations and foreign commercial banks with an aim of expanding the opportunities for financing the PPP projects;

implementation of the PPP projects based on a "programmatic approach" with the potential investors, coordination of the basic conditions with a private partner (profitability level, deadlines and implementation mechanisms);

b) until the end of 2024:

together with the Ministry of Digital Technologies (Sh. Shermatov) to introduce an electronic platform for PPP projects in order to digitalize each stage of the PPP projects implementation, and maintain a register and monitoring of the PPP projects;

to integrate the systems of the relevant ministries, departments and publicly owned

companies into this platform.

9. The ministries, agencies and publicly owned companies, within two weeks, shall submit to the Ministry of Economy and Finance the wording of all concluded PPP agreements, in order to ensure proper review of direct and conditional obligations assumed by the government; the Ministry of Economy and Finance (Zh. Karshibaev) shall ensure that these projects are included into the Register of Public-Private Partnership Projects in a simplified manner as an exception.

In addition, to ensure that all long-term investment projects based on the PPP principles are included into the Register of Public-Private Partnership Projects, with signed contracts and small projects under the framework of investment law.

10. In pursuance of the timely and effective implementation of each PPP project, to introduce the system as follows:

to hold quarterly critical discussions by the Cabinet of Ministers on implementation of the tasks set out herein;

the heads of ministries, agencies and business associations shall inform annually the Administration of the President of the Republic of Uzbekistan on the progress of PPP projects.

11. By November 1, 2024, the republican and municipal executive authorities, and business associations, together with the Ministry of Economy and Finance, shall develop and submit to the Cabinet of Ministers the comprehensive network schedules for implementation of each project as implemented based on the PPP included into the Program of projects for 2024-2030, with breakdown by the regions.

12. The Ministry of Economy and Finance (I. Norkulov), Ministry of Health (A. Khudayarov), Ministry of Culture (O. Nazarbayev), Ministry of Sports (A. Ikramov) and the Agency for the Management of State Assets (A. Ortikov), together with the Chairman of the Council of Ministers of the Republic of Karakalpakstan, the khokims of the regions and the city of Tashkent, by the end of 2024, shall conduct an inventory of large hospitals, cultural and sports facilities (including palaces of culture, stadiums, concert halls, recreation parks) that are used inefficiently and submit proposals to the Cabinet of Ministers on their transfer to the private sector based on the PPP.

13. To establish that the first heads of ministries, departments and municipal public authorities shall bear personal responsibility for full, high-quality and timely implementation of set targets and tasks, and for attracting potential investors.

14. To charge D.A. Kuchkarov, the Deputy Prime Minister with a personal responsibility for efficient organization of the execution of this Decree.

To charge A.N. Aripov, the Prime Minister of the Republic of Uzbekistan with responsibility for coordination and control over the activities of agencies responsible for implementation hereof.
